Corporate Work Study Program

Cristo Rey St. Martin offers affordable college preparatory education in a community where few other quality options exist. The signature and differentiating component of our school is the Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP). This nationally implemented educational model leverages the resources of local businesses and enables our students to fund the majority of his or her education, gain job experience, grow in self-confidence, and realize the relevance of his or her education.

- Reliable, successful workers The Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) is a professional, turnkey operation that provides screening, extensive training, support and transportation. Cristo Rey students have a 98% daily job attendance rate and routinely "meet or exceed expectations" on performance evaluations completed by supervisors.
- Payroll cost savings CWSP student workers cost less than hiring a single full-time employee, with no costs for benefits, vacations, or sick days.
- **No administrative expenses** All payroll, legal and tax paperwork is handled by CWSP.



- **Financial aid** Students apply all CWSP earnings towards tuition, covering approximately half of the cost.
- Real world experience Students work real jobs in law, finance, healthcare, marketing, universities and many other professional offices. They are challenged to apply their skills beyond the classroom, while learning about future career possibilities.
- New horizons Successful business leaders are role models for students, inspiring new goals and raising future ambitions. Students also develop positive relationships that can lead to summer jobs, college references and other job referrals.

 Martin means academic excellence, practical experience, maturity, and above all, integrity. Students are preparing to enroll and persist in college.

THE CRISTO REY BUSINESS MODEL




HOW IT WORKS

- Companies contract with the Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) for full-time, entry-level jobs.
- Students are employees of the CWSP, not the Sponsors.
- Four students share one job and provide coverage
 Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, from mid-August through early June.
- Students rotate their schedules, each working five full days a month. Academic schedules are structured so that students never miss class.
- Business Partners are charged a competitive \$29,500 fee for the services of the students. This fee is a business expense, NOT a donation.
- The Corporate Work Study Program is separately incorporated, functioning like a temporary employment agency within Cristo Rey St. Martin.



WHY IT WORKS

Our students want to learn and our teachers want to educate. Our students are willing to work and our families are willing to sacrifice. Your partnership sends deserving students to school!

Each Cristo Rey student works inside and outside of the classroom to ensure a better education. While carrying a full course load, every CRSM student participates in the Corporate Work Study Program to fund 50% of their tuition.

Through this program, every student works in a professional setting such as law firms, banks, hospitals and other professional corporate partners.



This work experience provides our students the opportunity to financially contribute to their education, and it also reinforces the thinking strategies & lifelong learning behaviors emphasized in the classroom. The workplace experience allows students to apply and make connections from the classroom to the world of work. This unique combination of classroom learning and workplace learning prepares Cristo Rey students for success in high school, in college, and in the years to come.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What can students do at my company?

Students perform data entry, Spanish-English translation services, document management, internet research, IT support, event support, financial accounting, mass mailings, reception, and most entry-level office work. Students work in Accounting, Communications, Customer Service, Human resources, Legal, Logistics, and Tax Departments. The wide variety of Corporate Work Study Program business partners allows students to be exposed to a more diverse corporate world and job descriptions vary by corporation. Q: Are students trained to work?

A: Before enrolling at Cristo Rey, each student participates in a 4-week training program that helps them prepare for success in the classroom and in the work environment. During this "Bridge Program" students learn Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint), attend Communication Seminars, and witness Professional Behavior Modeling. As part of training, students also attend 3 Day team-building retreat on college campus that welcomes them to the Cristo Rey family and introduces them to school's mission.

Q: Who monitors the student workers?

A: Each Corporate Work Study Program Business Partner provides a supervisor that manages Cristo Rey students and corresponds with CWSP staff to ensure productivity. CWSP staff visits each business site regularly to gather feedback and enforce student accountability. Each student is responsible for completing a daily time card (which includes an evaluative piece). Additionally, CWSP business partners complete Semester-End Performance Reviews to rate students. Today 95% of our student workers "Meet or Exceed Expectations" of their supervisors based on ratings.

Q: What comes next?

A: Become a Corporate Work Study Partner today! Our standard agreement outlines the CWSP guidelines and details of the \$29,500 annual fee. Remember, we handle all human resource services including monitoring and reporting attendance, coaching, performance training and workplace monitoring.
